

Zulal Water awarded 3 EPC water plant contract by Waha Oil Company

Zulal Water Technology (“ZWT”) today announced it had been awarded a contract by Waha Oil Company (“Waha Oil”) to provide three turnkey R.O Water plants at Waha’s Gialo, Waha and Essider oil camps.

Waha Oil is one of Libya’s largest oil producers, and the award follows a competitive tender process undertaken to find a replacement for Waha’s existing GE-Ionics EDR plants. The total capacity of the three proposed Zulal plants exceeds 4,000 m3/day.

Waha Oil has requested that the plants be commissioned in as short a timeframe as possible, and ZWT is targeting completion of the project during Q4 2013.

Iftikhar-ul-Haq, Managing Director of ZWT, commented: “This contract award reflects ZWT’s strong reputation and execution track record within the Libyan market. We very much look forward to working with Waha Oil again and are confident of completing the project on time and to the client’s satisfaction.”

Engineering Manager of Waha Oil commented: “Our existing GE-Ionics EDR plants are in poor condition and in urgent need of replacement. We selected ZWT based on the strength of their technical proposal and their ability to install high quality water plants in a short time frame, which they demonstrated when installing an emergency water plant for us recently at Waha site.”

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
